The Death.- occurred on Saturday after only a fortnight's illness of Mrs. Elizabeth Way, aged 72, of Thirlmere, Carisbrooke-road, widow of Mr. John Way, a former secretary of the I.W. Savings Bank. She had lived in Newport since her marriage nearly 50 years ago, having come from Cowes, where she was born. Mrs. Way was associated with her husband in church affairs at Carisbrooke and during the last war assisted in the work of the local hospital supplies depot. There is a family of two sons and a daughter. The Rev. H. Ewbank officiated at the funeral in Carisbrooke Church and cemetery on Wednesday, when the mourners were Messrs. W. J. and A. C. Way (sons), Mrs. W. J. Way (daughter-in-law), Mrs. Jacobs (cousin), Messrs. C. Bettenson (brother-in-law) and L. Bettenson (nephew), Mrs. Gray (cousin), and Mr. H. Phillips.
