Death of Mrs. K. Alabone.---The death took place on Sunday of Mrs. Kate Alabone, of 39 Carisbrooke-road, aged 89. A native of the Island, the deceased was the only daughter of the late Mr. Edward Johnson, who for some years resided at Newport prior to his removal to Ryde, where Mrs. Alabone was born. For 61 years deceased was the wife of Mr. Alfred Alabone, who for a long time was in practice as a dentist in the town and who died last November. Deeply interested in the work of the British and Foreign Bible Society, Mrs. Alabone was for 37 years the secretary of the local branch, and on her retirement in 1923 the society presented her with a suitably inscribed Bible in appreciation of her devoted services. She was also interested in St. John's Church and used to assist at the annual bazaars. She leaves no family. The funeral was in Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday, where the service was held. The Rev. W. H. Mackinnon officiated and the mourners were Messrs. H. A. and E. B. Dabell and L. Upward (nephews), Mrs. F. Rose, and the Misses K. and A. Etheridge (nieces), the Misses A. Barnes and E. Way, and Messrs. W. D. Way Buckell and Urry. There were numerous floral tributes.
