A Sad Bereavement.---Sincere sympathy has been aroused with Mr. M. W. J. Attrill, the esteemed licensee of The Bedford, Carisbrooke-road, and Mrs. Attrill, in the death at the County Hospital, Ryde, on Thursday, of their only daughter, Eileen Mary, at the early age of 17.
