OBITUARY. - We regret to announce the death of Mr. Fred Billows, aged 77, which occurred at 135 Carisbrooke-road on Wednesday. The deceased, who was a native of Poole, had a long connection with the Island. He was at one time the licensee of the Pembroke Hotel, Southampton, where he was well known and much respected. He afterwards kept licensed houses in Cowes and Newport, and for some seven years was employed at the Carisbrooke Brewery when owned by the late Mr. C. J. Dashwood.
