

**Reginald Thomas Brackey**

**The Late Mr. R. T. Brackey.** - A service for Mr. Reginald Thomas Brackey, aged 80, of St Wilfrid's, 39 Cypress Road, who died on Friday week, took place at the Parish Church on Thursday. Mr. Brackey, who lived in the town all his life, was for many years in business as a tailor in Upper High Street. He was associated with the Trustee Savings Bank, and in 1925 was appointed honorary manager. He was for many years a member of the Albany Lodge of Freemasons and in 1932 became Worshipful Master. During the 1939-45 war he was a member of the Town Council. The service was conducted by the Rev. F. G. Fuller (vicar). The principal mourners were Mrs. E. Brackey (widow), Mrs. H. Ruddock (step-daughter), Mr. R. Brackey (step-son), Mr. and Mrs. Hazard and Mrs. Whiston. Mr. A. Brackey (brother) was prevented by illness from attending. Representatives of the Albany Lodge of Freemasons were also present. Private cremation followed.
