CRIMEAN VETERAN'S FUNERAL. - The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday afternoon of Mr. Alfred Brown, aged 84, for many years a principal warder at H.M. Convict Prison, Parkhurst, who lived at Alvington-road, Carisbrooke, until the death of his wife, between two and three years ago, when he removed to Windsor in order to live with his son. He was well known and much esteemed and during his long residence in the Island he made many friends who will regret to hear of his death. The late Mr. Brown, in his younger days, saw a great deal of service in the Army, and he was one of the rapidly decreasing number of Crimean veterans left with us. His family largely inherited his patriotic spirit, for he has four sons in the Army.
