The Late Mr. A. E. Buckett. – The death occurred on Sunday of Mr. Austin Edward Buckett, aged 68, of 40 Cypress Road. Mr. Buckett, who is survived by his widow, three sons, and three daughters, was born in Newbridge and was apprenticed with Messrs. Flux, Ltd. as a bricklayer. On moving to Newport he worked for 26 years for Messrs. Quinton, but had to give up owing to failing health. He also attended Quay Street Methodist Church in earlier years. The funeral took place on Thursday at Carisbrooke Cemetery, conducted by the Minister of Pyle Street Methodist Church (the Rev. Cardy), deputising for the Rev. H. Harrison, who was unable to attend owing to illness. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. R., Mr. and Mrs. S., and Mr. C. Buckett (sons and daughters-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. B. Loader, Mr. and Mrs. V. Jones, and Mrs. Gaze (sons-in-law and daughters), Messrs. W., V., and A. Buckett (brothers), Mrs. B. Pragnell, Mrs. A., Mr. and Mrs. R., and Mr. and Mrs. O. Flux (brothers-in-law and sister-in-law), and Mrs. H. Buckett, representing her husband (cousin). Mrs. A. Buckett (widow) and Mesdames P. Strickland and J.
