NEWPORT

Death of Mr. A. G. Buckler. --- The funeral took place on Monday of Mr. Albert George Buckler, aged 71, who died at his home 30 College Road, on the previous Wednesday. Mr. Buckler joined the staff of Messrs. W. J. Rugg and Co., Ltd., in 1919 as a traveller, and on his retirement 42 years later was stores manager of the Newport wholesale department. Before his illness he was a keen gardener and a regular supporter of Newport Football Club. He was a member of the Needles Lodge of Freemasons. The service at St. John's Church was conducted by the Rev. S. F. Cooper (vicar). The mourners were Mrs. Buckler (widow), Mr. and Mrs. D. A. and Mr. and Mrs. E. R. Buckler (sons and daughters-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. F. Buckler and Mrs. L. Buckler (brother and sisters-in-law). Also represented were the directors of Messrs. W. J. Rugg and Co., Ltd., the directors of Messrs. Rugg and Sincok (Southampton), Ltd., the staff of all the company's Island and mainland branches and the Needles Lodge of Freemasons, all of whom sent floral tributes. Interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
