The family:

William (the father), died 19 July 1877, buried in Carisbrooke Cemetery

Elizabeth (nee James, Wife of William), died July 1857, buried St Mary's Church, Carisbrooke

Ellen, Landscape and Portrait Painter, Ellen died, Lake, nr. Sandown May 1898, buried Shanklin Cemetery 19 May 1898

John, Artist, died Southampton, 1893

William, Gunsmith, Engineer, Southampton, 'disappeared' mid 1880's -

Elizabeth married Alfred William Abraham, 1853, no sign of his death but in 1871 census Elizabeth is living as wife of George Robert Thompson (no sign of marriage and George died

1888, buried Carisbrooke Cemetery). Elizabeth died Newport 1900, buried Shanklin Cemetery 14 August 1900. Probate for Elizabeth Abraham shows died 10 August 1900, Newport – no death of Elizabeth Abraham recorded in Isle of Wight.

Ellen and Elizabeth, together with Sarah James of St. James Street signed the 1866 Women's Suffrage Petition.

Sarah James could possibly be Sarah James 1841 census, Lace worker, aged 25, daughter of William James, New Street, Carisbrooke – possibly sister (or other relation) of Elizabeth Cantelo nee James; 1861 census born Carisbrooke, lodger in Node Hill (ie St. James Street), aged 50, Milliner, born Carisbrooke - all census show unmarried; probably died 1886, buried Carisbrooke Cemetery although Burial Register shows as Widow.
