Business Man's Bereavement. – Much sympathy is felt with Mr. Edward Cave, coal merchant, of Trafalgar Road, in the death of his wife, which took place at their residence, St. Mary's Croft, Drake Road, on Tuesday after a long illness, at the age of 64. Mrs. Cave, who was a native of Westbourne, Sussex, had been a popular and esteemed worker for St. John's Church and for many local organizations. She was a member of the St. John's Mother's Meeting and of the St. Thomas's branch of the Mothers' Union, an active worker for the Conservative party since the days of the Primrose League and an enthusiastic member of the women's section of the British Legion (for 27 years), the Women's Institutes at Carisbrooke, Binstead, and Barton, and of the Townswomen's Guild. Her fellow members of the Legion formed a guard of honour at the funeral service at St. John's Church yesterday afternoon.
