THE LATE MR. F.A. CHEESMAN

The death took place on Sunday at 31 Balfour Road, North End, Portsmouth, of Mr. Frederick Archibald Cheesman, aged 67. Mr. Cheesman was well-known in the town, where he frequently spent holidays, during which he regularly attended the Parish Church and supported the St. Thomas's Bible Class, of which his sister-in-law, Mrs G.E. Mills, is the young ladies' leader. At Portsmouth Mr. Cheesman was a member of the congregation of St. Mark's, North End, and a trustee of the Portsmouth District of the Ancient Order of Foresters, and treasurer of Court Benevolence.

Giddens, Mesdames L. Angell, R.Atkey, W. Russell, and F. Hobbs, Mr. F Chiverton, Bro R.P.J. Downing (secretary, Court Benevolence), Bros. G.W. Martin and W.G. Holmes (Trustees, Portsmouth District Secretary, A.O.F.). Interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the many floral tributes including those from the Portsmouth District, A.O.F.; Court Benevolence, A.O.F.; and the St. Thomas's Bible Class. Messrs. H and F.
