NEWPORT

AN OLD AND ESTEEMED CITIZEN — has passed away in the person of Mr. John Clark, who died at Clatterford Farm, Carisbrooke, on Wednesday last, in his 79th year. The deceased came to the Island from Yorkshire some sixty years ago and took up a responsible position in the establishment of the late Mr. John Horniman, at Newport. He subsequently entered upon other engagements, and in 1860 he acquired the well-known grocery business in Node-hill, which he successfully conducted for a number of years and which is now carried on by his youngest son, Mr. Kirtlan Clark. About ten years since he removed to Clatterford, where, amid congenial surroundings, he spent the remainder of his days, enjoying there, as he had commanded in Newport, the sincere respect of all with who he came in contact. The sympathy of the community will be with the members of the bereaved family in the loss they have suffered. The funeral takes place to-day (Saturday).
