RETIRED dental surgeon Terence Grant Cleghorn has died aged 67.

A funeral service for Mr. Cleghorn has been held at Shanklin Methodist Church.

Mr. Cleghorn qualified as a dental surgeon at the University of Leeds in March 1960 and practised at Basingstoke until 1963 and then established his own practice in Castle Bromwich, Birmingham.

In September 1990, he contracted legionnaires disease and was forced to take early retirement.

His wife, Daphne, had been born in Newport and the family moved to the Island in 1998 and lived in Shanklin.

Mr. Cleghorn was closely involved with Rotary and the Royal British Legion and was a keen photographer, spending time with Cowes photographer Keith Beken.

Mr. Cleghorn was buried at Carisbrooke Cemetery and leaves his wife and a son, David.
