CARISBROOKE.

DEATH OF A CLERGYMAN. – An aged and honoured clergyman passed away at Carisbrooke on the 17th instant – the Rev. Thomas Coldwell, whose death occurred an hour or two before the completion of his 86th year. The deceased was rector of Green's Norton, diocese of Peterborough, to which he was appointed by the Crown in 1853. He was previously (1832-1853) vicar of Abthorpe, in the same diocese. He had been residing at Carisbrooke for the last two years in order to be near his daughter, the wife of the Rev. F. Rogers, curate of Carisbrooke. The funeral, which took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday last, was attended by the deceased's son, the Rev. G. H. H. Coldwell, and a number of Carisbrooke friends, several of whom sent floral crosses and wreaths.

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
