Death of Mrs. A. Colenutt.---The funeral took place on Saturday of Mrs. Alice Colenutt, of Southdene, 87 High Street, whose death occurred the previous Wednesday, aged 58. Mrs. Colenutt was a member of the Arnold family, the well-known travelling showmen, and was born at Malmesbury, Wiltshire. She came to the Island shortly after the first world war and in 1929 married Mr. Reginald Frank Colenutt. They made their home in Newport, coming to reside here about nine years ago. With her husband, Mrs. Colenutt took an active interest in fanciers' societies. She had been associated with the local society since its formation and was a familiar figure at shows preparing refreshments, a duty which she often undertook for the Cowes Society. During the last three years her health had been failing. The service at the cemetery was conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. J. Souttar). The mourners were Mr. Colenutt (husband), Mr. and Mrs. Albert and Mr. Alfred Arnold (brothers and sister-in-law), Mrs. R. Jenkins (sister), and Mrs. C. Riddet. Representatives of the Carisbrooke and Cowes Fanciers' Society also attended and sent floral tributes. The arrangements were made by Mr. F. Groundsell.
