Death of Mr. Sidney Cooper.--A well-known figure in the business life of the town, Mr. Sidney Cooper, proprietor of the Westminster Bone Mill, passed away at his residence, Redcott, Cypress-road, on Wednesday, at the age of 63. Mr. Cooper, a native of Swindon, came to the Island 20 years ago on acquiring the Westminster Bone Mill business and he had made many friends, who regret his passing.
