Death of Mr. S. Crabb.--The death occurred at the County Hospital on Saturday of Mr. Sidney Crabb, of 6 York-road, aged 42. He was formerly employed by Messrs. Croucher Bros. for 20 years, and latterly by Messrs. Wood and Jolliffe. The funeral service took place on Wednesday in St. Mary's Church, Carisbrooke, the Vicar (the Rev. H. Ewbank, R.D.) officiating. The mourners were Mrs. S. Crabb (widow), Mrs. A. N. Crabb (mother), Mr. and Mrs. Woolgar and Mr. and Mrs. B. Crabb (sons and daughters-in-law), Miss Robinson (sister-in-law) and Mrs. Leigh. Others present were Messrs. R. E. Core (Weeks, Ltd.), W.
