The Late Mr. G. Epps.- The funeral took place on Sunday of Mr. George Epps, of 26 Caesar's-road, whose death at the age of 65 we recorded last week. He was a much-esteemed tradesman, for many years associated with the late Mr. G. H. Frampton in, and later the proprietor of, the greengrocery business in the Upper High-street, which he disposed of about six months ago owing to ill-health. While his health permitted he was a regular worshipper at St. John's Church and the service was held there, the Vicar (the Rev. W. H. Mackinnon) officiating. The interment was at Carisbrooke. The chief mourners were Mr. and Mrs. C. Woodford and Mr. and Mrs. H. Barnes (sons-in-law and daughters), and Mr. W. Ash (brother-in-law). Mr. A. Epps (brother), and Mrs. Phippard (sister) were unable to attend. Among friends attending were Messrs. W. Watson, L. Ledicott, C. Cheverton, and C. Cole.
