The death occurred at St. Mary's Hospital on Thursday, of Mrs. Gertrude May Gentle, aged 73, of 8 Terrace Road. She was a member of the Victoria Methodist Church and Sisterhood, and in her younger days was a Sunday School teacher. Mrs. Gentle is survived by two sisters, one of whom is in Fiji, and a brother. The funeral service will take place on Monday at the Victoria Methodist Church at 2 o'clock.
