Former Royal Dairyman.- The death took place at the Royal I.W. County Hospital, on Tuesday week, of Mr. Harry Glasspell, aged 82, of 6. Castle Road. Mr. Glasspell was born at Whippingham and spent his early life on the Osborne Estate, where his parents were employed. On leaving school he worked at Osborne in Queen Victoria's dairies. He developed a great love of horses and became a coachman for a doctor and later drove for a miller. With the disappearance of horse-drawn vehicles, Mr. Glasspell took a position with the Co-operative Society here, and worked there until his retirement. He had lived in the town for 52 years. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Friday week the Rev. F. G. Fuller officiating. The mourners included Mr. and Mrs. Leal (son-in-law and daughter), Mrs. Ashwin and Mrs. Cheverton (daughters), Mr. and Mrs. Line (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. and Mrs. K. Glasspell (son and daughter-in-law), Messrs. R. and M. Leal and I. Glasspell (grandsons), Mr. M. B. Glasspell (grandson) and Mrs. Glasspell and Miss J. Glasspell (niece).
