Death of Mr. F. Gustar.- The death occurred on Thursday week at 7 Trafalgar-road of Mr. Frank Gustar, aged 78. For about 26 years he was in the employ of Messrs. Mew, Langton, and Company, at the Royal Brewery, and had since been employed by Mr. Reg Wells and Fred Trim Ltd., as a storeman. Mr. Gustar was one of the oldest members of the Ancient Order of Foresters. The funeral service was held in the Holyrood-hall on Monday, Mr. E. A. Walmsley officiating, and two of deceased's favourite hymns were sung. The mourners were Messrs. H. G. and J. Gustar (sons), Mesdames E. Church, E. Perkins, and B. Solloway (daughters), Messrs. P. Church, A. Perkins (sons-in-law), E. Taylor (brother-in-law), M. Neal, E. Whitewood, and the Misses J. and M. Church (grandchildren). There were also representatives from Messrs. Fred Trim, Ltd.
