The Late Mrs. A. T. Hardy.--The death occurred at St. Mary's Hospital on Monday week of Mrs. Annie Thornton Hardy, aged 80, of 135 Staplers Road, the home of her son and daughter-in-law, where she had been residing for many years. Mrs. Hardy was the widow of Mr. E. W. Hardy, formerly of 21 Clarence Road, and had been a semi-invalid since 1934. She had been a patient at the hospital for four days. The funeral took place on Friday week, a service at the Victoria Methodist Church being conducted by the minister (the Rev. D. J. Creamer). The hymns "Jesu. Lover of my soul" and "Leave God to order all thy ways" were accompanied by Mr. H. F. Payn at the organ. The mourners were Dr. and Mrs. D. V. N. Hardy, Mr. and Mrs. E. H. Hardy, and Mr. and Mrs. A. Hardy (sons and daughters-in-law), and Mrs. W. Stocks and Miss F. Hobbs (nieces). Mrs. Q. Wignall was unable to attend. The interment followed at Carisbrooke Cemetery and the floral tributes included one from the minister and members of the Victoria Methodist Church. Mr. W. W. Wells made the arrangements.
