Death of Mr. H. J. Harvey.--Sympathy is extended to Mrs. Harvey, of 40 West Street, in the death of her husband, Mr. Harold James Harvey, aged 52, at the County Hospital on Wednesday. He was well known as an ambulance driver and as a skilled member of the Island's ambulance service, and was held in affectionate regard. A native of the town, he was a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. J. Harvey. He worked in London for some years before returning to the Island in 1939, and joining the ambulance service. Mr. Harvey was an officer and secretary of the local St. John Ambulance Brigade. In the first world war he served with the I.W. Rifles, and later with the Oxon and Bucks L.I., being wounded at Ypres. He was a member of the I.W. Rifles O.C.A. and of the British Legion. The funeral will take place to-day (Saturday), service at St. Thomas's Church at 2 p.m.
