A broken column was erected last week in the cemetery at Carisbrooke, on which is the following inscription:

"In Memory of WILLIAM HEAL, late Secretary of the Isle of Wight Friend-in-Need Society, who died Novr. 10, 1862, Aged 61 years.

This Column was erected by Voluntary Subscription of the members as a fit emblem, and in grateful recognition of the services of one who during 18 years, by his integrity and unwearied exertions, contributed largely to the society's success."

The following lines were written (by John Dore) after viewing the column in Carisbrooke cemetery, erected to the memory of the above:

This column stands o'er one whose name Might well be on the scroll of fame.

Few give such proofs of sterling worth,
Who proudly boast of noble birth.

Many with pride his praise declare,
Therefore contributed to rear
This monument, that it may tell
Of him who did his duty well;
And that his worthy name might be
Revered by his prosperity.
