SUDDEN DEATH

The death occurred under tragic circumstances, on Monday, of Mrs. Matilda Maud Hendy, a widow, aged 69, who resided with her two sons at Park Place-cottages. She spent Christmas-day with her daughter, Mrs. Earley, at Rew-street, Northwood. On the following day she returned home at 2.35 p.m., accompanied by her niece, Miss P. Hendy, who lives at Dalton, Alvington-road. They travelled by bus to Carisbrooke, left it at the cross-roads near the church, and proceeded to walk up Alvington-shute. On the way Mrs. Hendy collapsed by the side of the road. A passing motorist (Mr. Carr, of Totland Bay) took Mrs. Hendy to her home in his car. Dr. Goodwin was immediately summoned and on his arrival at 3.45 p.m. could only pronounce life extinct. The deceased had not complained of feeling ill and was apparently in her usual health.
