### NEWPORT.

**AN IMPRESSIVE CEREMONY** – was witnessed at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Sunday afternoon last, when the mortal remains of Mr. Charles Henry Jones, a journeyman painter, of Trafalgar-road, whose death at the early age of 24 we announced last week, were laid in their last resting place. The funeral cortege was made up of about 70 members of the Earl Yarborough Lodge of Oddfellows, with Bro. T. H. Alexander, N.G., and a large muster of Lodge officers, about the same number of members of the St. John's Men's Bible Class, accompanied by their leader, Mr. James Eldridge, jun., and nearly 30 members of the St. Thomas's Club, with all of which Societies deceased was connected. A number of the deceased's fellow-workmen and members of Court Island Foresters were also present. Two members from each of the three Societies mentioned above acted as bearers. The officiating clergy at the grave were the Revs. R. R. Farrant (curate of St. Thomas's) and F. Rogers (curate of Carisbrooke). At the conclusion of the burial service a hymn was sung by the members of the Bible Class, after which Bro. F. B. Meager, Lecture Master of the Oddfellows, impressively read the funeral service of the Order. The coffin was covered with beautiful floral tributes sent by members of the Societies, relatives, and friends.
