The late Mrs. E. M. Rolf. — The funeral took place on Monday of Mrs. Eva May Rolf, aged 62, of 35 Whitesmith Road, who died on Thursday week. She was buried on the same day as the funeral at Eastbourne of her former employer, Mr. H. Whitehead, with whom she worked, as a secretary for Messrs. Smith and Whitehead, for many years. Mrs Rolf had been a lifelong member of the Pyle Street Methodist Church and for some years of the Methodist Sisterhood. The service was held at the Pyle Street Church, the Rev. P. H. Hanks officiating. The hymns were "Abide with me" and "The Lord is my shepherd." The mourners were Miss L. M. Rolf (step-daughter), Mr. and Mrs. R. J. S.
