The Late Mr. H. J. Knapp.---The death occurred at the residence of his son at Southampton, on Monday, of Mr. Harry James Knapp, formerly of Priory Road, in his 90th year. He was a member of the Cowes Court of the Ancient Order of Foresters for 65 years. He was also a member of the Darby and Joan Club and a trustee of the Gunville United Methodist Church. For over 50 years he had been employed as a mason by Messrs. James Ball and Son, of Cowes, and had lived in the village for over 40 years before moving to Southampton four years ago. His wife died in 1939. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday, the service at Gunville Methodist Church being conducted by the Rev. Dr. W. H. Mildon. The hymns "Jesu, Lover of my soul" and "Forever with the Lord" were sung. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. H. C. Knapp (son and daughter-in-law), Mrs. W. G. Thompson (daughter), Miss A. Knapp (niece), and Mrs. A. James. Wreaths were sent by the Darby and Joan Club and trustees of the Gunville United Methodist Church. The funeral arrangements were made by Messrs. H. V. Taylor and Son, of Ryde.
