Death of Mrs. A. E. Knott. – The death occurred at a nursing home on Sunday of Mrs. Annie Elizabeth Knott, formerly of Drake Road, aged 84. A native of Brighstone, Mrs. Knott was the widow of the late Mr. W. Knott, the proprietor of the Brewery, Orchard Street, who died in 1915. Until her health failed she was a worshipper at St. John's Church. The funeral service took place on Thursday at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the Vicar of Carisbrooke (the Rev. D. S. McKenzie) officiating. The mourners were Eng.-Comdr. B. W. Knott (step-son), Messrs. P. and A. and Miss L. Trickett (nephews and niece), Mr. and Mrs. J. Knott, Messrs. G. and F. Cooper, F. Attrill, and W. D.
