Death of War Veteran. — The death took place on Thursday week at St. Mary's Hospital of Mr. Herbert Walter Lockhart, aged 76, of 31 of Melbourne Street. A veteran of two wars, he held the South African war medal with three bars and the Mons Star, having fought in the Duke of Cornwall's Light Infantry from the outset of the 1914-18 war. Until recently, he was a member of the British Legion and of the I.W. Branch of the Old Contemptibles' Association. Mr Lockhart was twice married and leaves three daughters and four sons three of the latter by his second marriage. The funeral service took place on Tuesday at Carisbrooke Cemetery, conducted by the Rev. W. Cardy. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
