DEATH OF MR. G. S. LOWER, OF KITBRIDGE

The death occurred at Kitbridge Farm, on Tuesday, of Mr. George Samuel Lower, aged 55, who was well known as a dairy farmer and pig breeder. Mr. Lower was the fourth son of the late Mr. Benjamin Lower, pork butcher, whom he succeeded at Kitbridge some 30 years ago. He had been in failing health for some time and last year found it necessary to sell his fine herd of dairy cattle and give up his extensive milk round in the town. Mr. Lower was a skilful pig breeder and had won prizes for his pigs at the Royal I.W. Agricultural Society's shows and at the Gilten Market. His cheerful ways and upright business reputation won him many friends, who deplore his death at such an early age and deeply sympathise with his widow and daughter in their bereavement. The funeral takes place this (Saturday) afternoon; service in the Parish Church at 3 p.m.

The funeral of Mr. G. S. Lower, of Kitbridge Farm, was on Saturday, a service being held in the Parish Church and the interment being in Carisbrooke Cemetery. The Rev. H. Ewbank, R.D. (vicar of Carisbrooke) officiated, the hymns "Rock of Ages" and "Abide with Me" were sung, and his niece (Miss K. Lower, L.R.A.M.) the organist of the church, played "O rest in the Lord" and Walford Davies' "Solemn Melody". The chief mourners were the widow, Miss P. Lower (daughter), Mr. and Mrs. W. J. Lower and Mr. Horace Lower (brothers and sister-in-law), the Misses Ethel and Emily Lower (sisters), Mr. and Mrs. A. L. Dore and Mr. and Mrs. W. G. Bartlett (brothers-in-law and sisters), Mr. S. Brown (uncle), Mrs. Herbert Lower (sister-in-law), Mr. H. B. J. Lower (nephew), Miss Mavis Bartlett (niece), Mr. Don Lower (nephew), Mr. and Mrs. W. Kearney and Mr. R. Meech (brothers-in-law and sister-in-law), Mrs. H. B. J. Lower, Mr. J. Dave, Mr. and Mrs. H. E. Maynard, Mr. and Mrs. E. Pearson, Miss M. Sibbick, and Mr. J. D. Robinson. Mrs. F. J. Lower (mother), Mr. Hilton Lower (brother), Mr. and Mrs. F. Meech (Eastleigh), Mr. and Mrs. A. Maidment (Liverpool), and Miss F. Meech were prevented from attending, either through indisposition or travelling restrictions.
