Death of Mr. A. McKeown.- The death occurred at his residence, 158 High-street, on Tuesday week, of Mr. Alexander McKeown , aged 62. Mr. McKeown had resided here for five years and was a full-time member of the Civil Defence. He was a member of the Old Contemptibles' Association and the British Legion. The funeral took place on Friday week in the Roman Catholic Church, the Rev. Father Lynch officiating. The mourners were the widow, Messrs. J. T., and B. McKeown (sons), Mesdames Wells, Murphy, and M. Gibson (daughters), Sergt. Wells, Hants Regiment and Mr. M. Gibson (sons-in-law), Mr. J. McKeown (brother), Mrs. J. McKeown (sister-in-law), Miss P. McKeown (niece), and Messrs. J., F., R., and D. McKeown (nephews), and Mrs. R. Bailey and Nurse S. E. Murphy (nieces).
