The Late Mrs. E. McKeown.--The funeral service took place at St. Thomas of Canterbury Roman Catholic Church on Thursday, of Mrs. Elizabeth McKeown, aged 82, of 158 High Street, who died at 11 High Street, on Monday. Born in County Monaghan, Ireland, she came to the Island in 1940 from Maidstone, Kent, where she had lived for three years. Her husband worked at the Saunders-Roe division of Westland Aircraft, Ltd., and during the last war was an air-raid warden in the town. He died in 1945. Mrs. McKeown, who was well-known in the district, had 21 grandchildren and 30 great-grandchildren. She had resided with her daughter since Christmas. Fr. P. O'Mahoney officiated. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. A. Wells, Mr. and Mrs. M. Murphy and Mr. and Mrs. R. Jacobs (sons-in-law and daughters), Mr. T. MacKeown and Mr. and Mrs. B. McKeown (sons and daughter-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. R. Knapp and Mr. K. Wells (grandchildren), Mrs. M. McKeown (sister-in-law), Mr. A. McKeown and Mrs. R. Bailey (nephew and niece). Floral tributes included those from friends and neighbours. Interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The arrangements were made by Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son.
