SUDDEN DEATH. – The death occurred suddenly early on Sunday morning of Mrs. Miriam Emily Mills, aged 83, of Forest Villa, South-mall. The deceased had been a widow for some 20 years and during that time had lived with her brother, Mr. A. G. Midlane, at the above-named address. About eight years ago she had the misfortune to fall on the pavement and injured her leg and since then she had been subject to bronchitis, but had not been medically attended. Her brother, who is 81, and the only other occupant of the house was unable to obtain an answer when he knocked at her bed-room door on Sunday morning. Dr. Raymond, who was summoned, found that life was extinct. The Deputy Coroner (F. A. Joyce, Esq.) decided that an inquest was not necessary
