THE FUNERAL - of Miss K. E. Moorman, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James Moorman, of 42 Medina-avenue, whose death was recorded last week, took place on Monday. The first part of the service was held in the Parish Church, the Rev. T. V. Ruddock (curate) officiating, assisted by the Rev. Miles Atkinson (vicar of St. Paul's St. Paul's, Barton). Miss M. Scadding was at the organ and played "I know that my Redeemer liveth," "Angels ever bright and fair," and other music before the service and "O rest in the Lord" as the cortege left the church. About 20 members of the I.W. (164) V.A.D. in charge of their commandant (Miss Long) formed a guard of honour at the entrance to the church. The coffin was covered with the Red Cross flag. The family mourners were Mr. and Mrs. James Moorman (parents), the Misses Moorman (aunts), R. Jackman and M. Jolliffe, Mr. E. Marsh and Mrs. Martin (cousins), Mrs Toogood, and Mrs. Holbrook. Those also present included Messrs. A. J. and A. H. Cross, F. Chiverton, E. White, E. Hazard, C. Damp, and S. Burgess, Mrs. C. E. Yelf, Mrs. F. E. Whitcher, Mrs. K. Lockhart, and Miss Q. Witham. The interment followed at Carisbrooke Cemetery.
