**THE LATE MR. COUNCILLOR EDWIN MOREY.** – The funeral of this respected gentleman took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Friday last, the ceremony being performed by the Rev. J. H. Batt, and the Rev. W. B. Lark. The latter came from the mainland to pay a last tribute of respect to the memory of an old friend, with whom he was intimately associated in the work of the Bible Christian denomination in the Island a few years since. Mr. Councillor F. E. Morey (son), and several other relatives were present at the funeral, and there also attended the Mayor (Morris Morgan, Esq.), Mr. Ald. Johnson, Mr. Ald. Snellgrove, Councillors Bullen, Salter, Denness, and King, Mr. F. W. B. Waterworth, borough surveyor, and a large number of members of the Hand-in-Hand Friendly Society, of which deceased was a highly-respected officer.
