#### CHILLERTON

**NOT LONG SEPARATED.**- We regret to have to record the death of Mr. Charles Morgan, of Roslin Farm, near Chillerton, which took place on Tuesday, the 11th inst., at the ripe old age of 80 years. Deceased had been ailing for some time past and death was due to syncope. He was one of the old school of farmers, now almost extinct, and was born at Roslin Farm, which he took over from his father, and occupied till some seven years ago when he was succeeded by his son-in-law, Mr. J. H. Russell, the present occupier. It is a fact worthy of note that the deceased's father and grandfather had previously occupied Roslin Farm, and that the farm has been held by the same family over 150 years. The funeral took place on Friday afternoon last at Carisbrooke Cemetery, and hardly had the body of the husband been laid to its last resting place when the relatives were plunged into fresh grief by the death of the wife, Mrs. Rosetta Morgan, which took place on Saturday last, after an illness of some nine days, resulting from bronchitis. Her age was 73. The funeral before referred to was attended by Messrs. J. H. Russell and D. Brown, of Chawton (sons-in-law), G., M., and T. Morris (brothers-in-law), and Messrs. R. Y. Morgan (Ramsdown), Oliver Morgan (Gunville), E. Morgan, J. Morgan and F. Morgan (Newport), R. Morgan (Elm), T. Morgan and C. Morgan (Chillerton), Mr. H. M. Morris, C.A., G. Duke (Standen), R. A. Saunders, Mark Peach, and others. The Rev. Rogers impressively officiated. The funeral of the late Mrs. Morgan took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday last in the presence of a number of mourning relatives. Mr. T. Morgan carried out the funeral arrangements.
