**DEATH OF MR. OSMOND MORRIS.** – An esteemed resident and familiar figure in the town was removed by the death on Sunday at West End House, Carisbrooke-road, of Mr. Osmond Morris, for over 70 years a milk-purveyor from the Pan Farm dairy, and former tenant of Atherfield Farm. He was a son of Mr. David Morris, who many years ago farmed Hardingshute, Brading. The deceased had not enjoyed good health since the sudden death of his wife some 20 years ago, and had been confined to the house for many months. He was 78 years of age. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday, the vicar of St. John's (the Rev. W. H. Mackinnon) officiating, the interment being by the side of his late wife. The mourners were Messrs. Hilton and Douglas Morris (sons), Messrs. William, George, and Henry Morris (nephews), Mrs. P. Russell, and Messrs. James, Horatio, Ernest, Frederick, Hayden, and Wallace Morris (cousins), and Messrs. A. Henton, C. H. Cowdery, M. and H. Russell, A. Westmore, W. Wells, A. Brown, and W. Upton. Messrs. C. Dabell, J.P., R. Y. Morgan, Micah Morris, E. Russell and W. H. Wadham were prevented from attending. Mr. H. W. Parnell made the arrangements.
