Sudden Death.- Sincere sympathy is felt for Mr. and Mrs. C. Phillips, of 14 Trafalgar-road, in the tragic death of their 16-year-old daughter, Dorothy Christine, who was found dead in bed by her mother at about 8 a.m. yesterday (Friday) morning. The deceased, who was formerly a pupil at the Nodehill Council School, had been temporarily employed at Sandown by the Eldorado Ice Cream Co. She was to have had a day off yesterday, and consequently was not called early. Dr. A. A. Straton was immediately summoned, but could only pronounce life extinct. The facts have been reported to the Coroner.
