THE LATE MR. H.W. POINTER

The funeral service took place at St. John's Church on Thursday week for Mr. Harold William Pointer, aged 68, of 79 St. John's Road, who died at St. Mary's Hospital the previous Sunday. An Islander, Mr. Pointer served in the Hampshire Regiment during the 1914-18 war. He was married in 1915. For 43 years he was employed by John Sheath and Co., working as a delivery driver in the earlier years and latterly in the stores.

The vicar (the Rev. S.F. Cooper) officiated. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. R., Mr. and Mrs. W. and Mrs. and Mrs. E. Pointer (sons and daughters-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. C. Spencer, Mrs. C Holdaway and Mr. and Mrs. A. Pritchard (sons-in-law and daughters), Mesdames W. Welstead, F. Chiverton, Westwood, A. Wake, and A. Drudge (sisters), Mr. W. Pointer (brother), Mr. G. Linington and Mrs. S. Chiverton (nephew and niece) and Mr. L. Nichols. Messrs. John Sheath and Co. and the Borough Hall Garage were represented and sent floral tributes. Interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery in the grave of his wife, who died in 1955. Mr. A.E. Wyatt made the arrangements.
