Deputy Postmaster's Bereavement. – The death occurred on Tuesday, after a long illness, of Mrs. Florence Punch, aged 65, wife of the deputy postmaster, Mr. A. E. Punch, of 83 Clatterford Road, Carisbrooke. Mrs. Punch, a native of Cornwall, came here with her parents in 1917 and was a clerk in the head Post Office. Her husband was also a member of the Post Office clerical staff and they married in 1921. Mrs. Punch shared her husband's enthusiasm for gardening, particularly in flower culture, and on several occasions had exhibited at the local horticultural shows. Much sympathy is felt with Mr. Punch and his son and two daughters in their loss.
