The Late Miss K. C. Riley.—Sincere sympathy is felt with Mrs. E. Riley, of 5 Albany-road, in the death on Sunday week of her last surviving daughter, Miss Kathleen Clara Riley, aged 32. Mrs. Riley, whose husband, Principal Officer Edward Riley, died in 1931, had suffered the loss of three daughters previously and is now left with only one son.
