Death of Mrs. A. Sanger.- The death took place on Sunday, following an operation at the County Hospital, of Mrs. Amy Kate Sanger, of 12 Hearn-street, well known as a skilful needlewoman who made many of the costumes for the Wight Strollers' productions, and for the dancing displays by the pupils of Miss Nellie Furmage. Her death at the early age of 47 is much deplored by her many friends. Her husband, Lce.-Corpl. A. Sanger, of the I.W. Rifles, lost his life in Palestine during the last war. She leaves one daughter. The funeral took place on Wednesday. At the service in the Congregational Church, conducted by the Rev. R. Sirhowy Jones, her favourite hymn, "O happy band of pilgrims," was sung, and the interment was at Carisbrooke. The mourners were Driver R. H. Wills, R.A.S.C., and Mrs. Wills (son-in-law and daughter), Miss M. Trowbridge (sister), Mr. Horace Dabell (brother-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. Jackson, and Mr. A. Bryant (cousins), Mr. and Mrs. B. Scovell, Mrs. Palmer, and Miss M. Ranger. There were over 20 floral tributes.
