Nonagenarian's Death.— The death occurred on Sunday at her residence, 2 Linden-road, of Miss Eleanor Mary Hookey Saunders, aged 80. She was a lifelong member of the Baptist Church, and was a Sunday-school teacher until she left to take up business at Torrington, Devon, and on her return from there in 1912 she resumed her work in the school. She was also, with the assistance of the late Miss M. Jackman, leader of the Junior Christian Endeavour at the Church. She was a native of the borough, and had been ill since May. The funeral took place on Wednesday in the Castlehold Baptist Church, the Rev. G. Barry Morgan officiating. The mourners were Mrs. Cooke and the Misses N. and T. Saunders (sisters), Mrs. Pay and Mrs. Steele (nieces), Mr. Way (nephew), Mesdames Way, Winscom, Cassford, and H. Way, and Messrs. Steele, Augustus, and Lacey. The internment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery, Messrs. H. and F. Damp making the arrangements.
