NEWPORT

SUDDEN DEATH. – The death took place suddenly on Wednesday night of Mr. Harry Scott, painter of Melbourne-street, New-village. The deceased, who was 43 years of age, was a prominent and enthusiastic member of the local Foresters and Shepherds, being past chief ranger of the Court Island Foresters and a past pastor of the local Sanctuary. He was also a member of the Newport Football Club, and his presence was very familiar on the local ground on match days. Much sympathy with his widow and child is felt by the deceased's friends and acquaintances, to whom the intelligence of his death came as a shock, as he appeared in his usual health until the night of the fatal seizure.
