Death Follows Fall.--The Deputy Coroner (R. E. A. Webster, Esq.) held an inquest at Ryde Town-hall on Monday on Mrs. Elizabeth Self, aged 92, who died in a Ryde nursing home on Saturday, following a fall at her home, 94 Carisbrooke-road, on July 16th. After hearing the evidence of her son and of Dr. A. C. Liesching, the Coroner returned a verdict of death from natural causes, accelerated by a fracture of the right fibia, sustained in an accidental fall. Mrs. Self was the widow of the late Mr. John Dawson Self, who died 20 years ago. The funeral was on Wednesday. The Vicar (the Rev. H. Ewbank, R.D.) officiated at a service in Carisbrooke Church and in the Cemetery. The chief mourners were Mr. J. A. Self (son), Mrs. Simmonds (granddaughter), Mr. N. Shutler (grandson), Mrs. M. Fox (niece), Mrs. Brading, Mr. and Mrs. Hartnell, Mr. L. Dore, Miss Dorcas Dore, and Mrs. Adams. Also present in church were Miss Underwood and Mrs. Jordan.
