**Former Licensee's Death.-** The death occurred at St. Mary's Hospital on Thursday week of Mrs. Ellen Amelia Shipsey, aged 79, of Meerist Wood, Pallance Road, Northwood. Mrs. Shipsey was the widow of Mr. E. G. Shipsey, a former chief petty officer, who in 1930 became the licensee of the Grapes Hotel. Mrs. Shipsey became the licensee upon his death in 1940 and held it until 1945. The funeral service on Wednesday at Carisbrooke Cemetery was conducted by the Rev. S. F. Cooper. The mourners were Mr. E. F. Shipsey (son), Mr. P. E. Shipsey (grandson), Mr. F. Gladdis (brother), Mr. A. Flux (brother-in-law), and Mrs. G. Gladdis and Mesdames W. Gardener, F. Day and G. Squibb (nephew and nieces). Mrs. E. Shipsey (daughter-in-law), Mrs. A. Flux (sister), and Mesdames J. and F. Gladdis (sisters-in-law), were unable to attend. Messrs. O. C.
