**The Late Mrs. E. Sibbick.**—The death occurred on Saturday at her home, 28 School Lane, of Mrs. Elizabeth Sibbick, aged 82, wife of Mr. Edward Sibbick, a former Prudential Assurance agent, who retired 16 years ago. Mrs. Sibbick, who had been in ill health for five years, was a native of Newport and had lived at School Lane for almost half a century. She and Mr. Sibbick celebrated their golden wedding three years ago. As a young girl she frequently visited Osborne House and could recall seeing Queen Victoria there.

The funeral service at the Chapel-on-the-Hill on Wednesday was conducted by the Rev. G. L. W. Ridge (Methodist minister). Interment followed at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The mourners were Mr. E. Sibbick (husband), Mr. and Mrs. P. H. Warne (son-in-law and daughter), Mrs. R. H. Cotton (daughter), Mr. W. G. Sibbick, J.P. (brother-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. A. V. Sibbick (brother-in-law and sister-in-law), Mrs. A. Sibbick (niece), Mrs. L. McGahey, and Mr. and Mrs. F. Attrill. Mr. R. E. Sibbick (son) and Mr. G. Warne and Mrs. G. W. Gawne (grandchildren) were unable to attend. The floral tributes included those from friends and neighbours. Mr. A. E. Wyatt made the arrangements.
