DEATH OF MR. G. R. TAYLOR.----The death occurred on Sunday, after a month's illness, of Mr. George Richard Sampson Taylor, aged 63, of 68 Medina-avenue. Born at Shide, he had lived in the district all his life, and was a dairy farmer at Morn Hill for two years and at Standen Farm for five years before entering the employ of Messrs. H. W. Morey and Sons, the well known timber merchants. He retired at the end of last year, at which time he was yard foreman. In February he suffered the loss of his wife, a blow from which he never fully recovered. One daughter, Mrs. F. W. Payne, of 66 Medina-avenue, is left in bereavement. Mr. Taylor was a regular attendant at the Quay-street Methodist Church, where the funeral service took place on Thursday. The Rev. J. Higman officiated, and Mr. W. G. Bartlett, at the organ, played "The Lord is mindful" and "O rest in the Lord" (Mendelssohn), and accompanied the singing of "Beneath the Cross of Jesus." The immediate mourners were: Mr. and Mrs. F.
