DEATH OF MR. JOHN V. TRICKETT. – A much respected tradesman of the town passed away on Sunday in the person of Mr. John Vince Trickett, of Cintra, Clifford-street, at the age of 64. Deceased was a coach and carriage builder, and had been in business for close upon a quarter of a century, for some time with Mr. G. Mew, of Wootton, and prior to that for some 19 years he worked at the establishment of Messrs. R. Bird Cheverton and Sons. In spite of failing health he kept at business practically till the end. Deceased was held in high esteem by a wide circle of friends, and much sympathy is felt with the widow and family in their bereavement. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke on Wednesday, the Vicar (the Rev. T. Story Busher) officiating. The principal mourners were Miss Trickett (daughter), Mr. W. Alderslade (son-in-law), Mrs. Austin Switzer and Mrs. H. Smith (daughters), Mr. H. Smith (son-in-law), Mr. C. F. J. Bath (nephew), Mr. Harry Jacobs, Brading (cousin), and Ald. R. Bird Cheverton, J.P. There were a number of beautiful floral tributes, including one from Mr. Ernest Switzer (Durham). The widow and Mrs. W. Alderslade (daughter) were too unwell to attend.
